Please join us in Seattle for the next **American Apitherapy Society Course and Conference** (CMACC, or the Charles Mraz Apitherapy Course and Conference, named after Mraz, a pioneer in apitherapy). Seattle is one of the most beautiful cities in the nation, all the more so in springtime. Located on Puget Sound with the majestic Olympic Mountains and Olympic Peninsula to the west, and Cascade Mountain Range to the east – including

Mt. Rainier and Mt. Baker which can be seen from downtown Seattle -- the city has magnificent views of water and mountains from seemingly every place you stand. Seattle is also known for its rich cultural life, large number of wonderful cafes and restaurants, and many delightful places to visit, such as the world-renowned Pike Place Market. We have chosen a conference center just north of the downtown business district that is a short distance from interesting neighborhoods and many fine eateries.

AAS is pleased to announce that we have made changes to the format and content of CMACC from previous years:

- A Course for Beginners will be held on one day (Friday, April 4).
- The Conference will be held on Saturday and Sunday morning, with a Saturday evening BVT workshop.
- An optional dinner at an additional cost will be held on Friday night in order that people attending either the Course or the Conference or both can attend. This event is essentially social, and will provide the opportunity for attendees and presenters to meet and talk.
- New speakers at CMACC include: Wally Blohm of Queens, New York; John Gibeau of Surrey, British Columbia; Chris Kleronomos, D.Ac of Bothell, Washington; Brad Weeks, MD, of Clinton Washington. Profiles of these and other presenters will be available soon on the AAS website.
- New topics will be presented at the Conference. See the Program on the website.
- Panels and Question and Answer Sessions have also been added.

The venue of CMACC is the Quality Inn, a reasonably priced hotel which provides free parking, high speed internet access, an indoor pool & hot tub, and is located minutes from all downtown attractions. It is two blocks from the Seattle Center and the Space Needle. From the airport, the hotel can be reached in about a half hour by the Shuttle Express.
